

GUIDELINES FOR CLERGY SUPPLY
January 1, 2010

In an emergency when a parish priest is not able to look after pastoral duties or Sunday services, the following procedure should be followed:

- ◆ The priest or churchwardens should inform the Regional dean and/or Archdeacon. Every effort should be made to provide pastoral support and Sunday supply locally.
- ◆ If support and/or Sunday supply cannot be provided locally, the Executive Officer can provide a list of available priests who could assist for a longer period of time.
- ◆ When a parish is without an incumbent for more than a month, either through illness or during an interim between incumbents, the Bishop or Executive Officer will make more permanent arrangements for priestly ministry during the illness or vacancy. The Regional Archdeacon, Regional Dean and churchwardens of the parish will be informed.

◆ Sermon only	\$ 112.00
◆ One Service with sermon.	\$143.00
◆ One Service with sermon for each congregation in a parish with more than one congregation (cost to be shared by each congregation)	\$201.00
◆ Early Eucharist and later Service with sermon	\$171.00
◆ Three consecutive Services in a day at the same church	\$201.00

Travel - \$0.45 per km. Plus hospitality.
