

SURVIVE & THRIVE OUTREACH IN THE NAME OF CHRIST ENDOWMENT FUND

Outreach Mission Statement

***To create and strengthen responsible relationships which promote peace,
justice, and the stewardship of creation.***

APPLICATION CRITERIA

- *Survive & Thrive* Outreach Funds are intended to enable the outreach mission work of parishes, in accordance with the Outreach Mission Statement (above). Applicants can receive assistance in preparing a successful application by calling Karen Nowicki at the Synod Office for a referral to one of the committee members.
- Short-term, and long-term projects are eligible for funding. All project proposals shall be submitted on the [application form](#).
- Grant money shall be used for those components of the project that contribute to creating and/or strengthening relationships which promote peace, justice, and the stewardship of creation. For example, the costs of delivering programs related to the Outreach Mission Statement would qualify, whereas construction costs would not.
- Grants are made as 'seed money' for new projects, not for the ongoing, long-term costs of established projects.
- Projects will not be funded retroactively.
- The maximum grant per project per year is \$5,000.
- Grants are awarded on a yearly basis. Renewals will be considered up to a maximum of three years, provided the reporting requirement has been fulfilled.
- All applications should include a full budget for the year, including other sources of funding.
- Long-term projects should include a plan for how the project will become self-sustaining by the end of the granting period.
- The deadline for applications is October 30th of the year before the project is due to begin.

REPORTING REQUIREMENTS

- A project evaluation report shall be submitted within 60 days of the completion of the project, using the project [reporting form](#).
- Applications for project renewal grants will not be considered unless the evaluation report has been received on time.
- Applications for new project grants will not be considered unless the evaluation report of a previously completed project has been received on time.
